Contributing Factors to achieve 100% AYP:

- After school tutoring was offered through both Supplemental Educational Services (SES) and a school-sponsored program
- Three times per week, students in grade 3 and up took a study skills class after school where they learned time management, organization, etc.
- Students in grades 2-8 received intense intervention pullouts of 45 minutes daily in groups of eight or less where they moved through the standards one at a time
- School day was extended by 60 minutes for the entire year
- Administration completed goal-setting activities with teachers, faculty, and students – FCAT was not part of the goals, but based on Bloom's Taxonomy and mindset psychology
- Teachers finished teaching grade level material for the year by the end of the third nine weeks then students physically changed classrooms to spend the last nine weeks with a teacher at the next grade level to start working on the skills for the next school year – this has been done the past two years and has helped with jumping right into teaching at the start of the new year
- Summer school program was offered three weeks before school starts rather than at the end of the previous school year
