EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the rule amendment is to adopt the 2009 Supplement to the State Requirements for Educational Facilities to address changes made in Florida Law during the 2009 legislative session and to update forms to meet requirements of rule and law.

The 2009 Supplement to the State Requirements for Educational Facilities, Sections 4.1, Professional Services and Construction Techniques; 4.2, General Contract Procedures; and Office of Educational Facilities Forms 110A, Project Implementation Information; 110B, Certificate of Occupancy; 208, Letter of Transmittal; and 209, Certificate of Final Inspection; are being updated. Changes include raising the threshold limits for Day Labor and for when a board must bid a capital improvement project from \$200,000 to \$300,000, and electrical work from \$50,000 to \$75,000. Changes also include providing requirements for when a board uses their own labor and equipment to complete capital improvement projects that cost \$300,000 or more. Forms are being updated to include identification of Green Building Standards used for a capital improvement project and information required by Florida Building Code.
