EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed rule specifically defines the term “expanded feeder chain” as a school that either sends or receives a majority of its students directly to or from a charter school that is currently receiving capital outlay. It also clarifies the term “satisfactory student achievement” for purposes of charter school capital outlay by incorporating the performance measures in the charter contract and excluding any charter school that receives an “F” grade.
