**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The proposed revisions will allow curricular flexibility in the provision of education to youth in Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) education programs. This will allow programs to customize educational services based on individual student needs. Examples may include flexible student scheduling, competency-based programming, and integration of academic and vocational curriculum. Additionally, the revisions will align the rule with Florida Statutes, including removing early delinquency intervention programs from the title as Department of Juvenile Justice education programs are composed of detention, commitment, and day treatment programs.
