EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Rule 6A-14.0061, F.A.C., Campus, Center, Special Purpose Center and Instructional Site Designations, provides that the State Board of Education review and recommend for or against the establishment of campuses, centers and special purpose centers. To obtain State capital outlay and operating support, the facilities must be designated a campus, center or special purpose center. Based on the documentation presented by the college, all the criteria stipulated in Rule 6A-14.0061, F.A.C., are satisfied. The college is requesting to change the site designation of the Altamonte Springs Center from a Center to a Campus. This site was established as a Center in 1996. The primary threshold for a Campus in Rule 6A-14.0061(2), F.A.C., is an instructional and administrative unit offering a full range of instructional services and of institutional, instructional, and student support services, staffed primarily by full-time personnel, and providing facilities and other resources sufficient to accommodate a projected enrollment of at least 1,000 FTE. This request satisfies those guidelines.
