Subject: Change in Site Designation

Dear Dr. Holcombe:

Pensacola Junior College's Milton Center (site 4) was approved by the state as a "center" in 1983. This 233± acre site in Santa Rosa County includes approximately 115,000 square feet of facilities. A diverse range of college courses and programs are offered, as well as comprehensive instructional and student support services.

FTE enrollment at the Milton Center last year (2008-09) was 1,063. Current State approved FTE projections for FY 2013-2014 at this site show an increase to 1,371 FTE. Per FAC rule 6A-14.0061, this site meets the requirements for "campus" site designation.

This request for change in site designation to "campus" was approved by the college's District Board of Trustees at its August 18, 2009, meeting (minutes enclosed). Therefore, on behalf of the District Board of Trustees, via this correspondence, I am requesting a change in this site designation, and ask that you place the request on the Florida State Board of Education's October meeting agenda for consideration.
