



## K-20 EDUCATION PERFORMANCE ACCOUNTABILITY MILESTONES AND TIMELINES

<b>DATE</b>	<b>ACTIVITY</b>
<b>June 17, 2003</b>	State Board of Education (SBE) considers approval of proposed work plan
<b>June 20, 2003</b>	Commissioner Horne appoints K-20 Task Force members and Chancellors appoint Sector Task Force members
<b>July 15-December 1, 2003</b>	Cooperate with each delivery system to develop proposals for performance-based funding, using performance measures
<b>July 22, 2003</b>	Conduct Summit I
<b>July 22-October 7, 2003</b>	Conduct Sector K-20 and Sector Task Force meetings Obtain public input
<b>August 19, 2003</b>	SBE adopts guiding principles for establishing state and sector-specific measures and standards
<b>October 8, 2003</b>	Conduct Summit II
<b>November 5, 2003</b>	Commissioner Horne's K-20 Policy Team identifies common definitions, measures, standards, and performance improvement targets to recommend to the SBE
<b>November 18, 2003</b>	SBE adopts common definitions, measures, standards, and performance improvement targets SBE determines the standards for the required data
<b>By December 1, 2003</b>	SBE will recommend to the Legislature common definitions, measures, standards, and performance improvement targets
<b>By December 1, 2004</b>	Department of Education will recommend to the Legislature a formula for performance-based funding that applies accountability standards for the individual components of the public education system toward meeting the system-wide goals for public education
