**SUBJECT:** Review of Community College Presidential Evaluations

---

**PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

Section 240.319(4)(a), Florida Statutes, provides that each local board of trustees conduct periodic evaluations of the president and submit the evaluations to the State Board of Community Colleges (which is now the Florida Board of Education by virtue of the Type 2 transfer) for review.

Historically, the State Board of Community Colleges reviewed the evaluations to assure that the requirements of statutory provisions relating to local board review evaluations were met. Section 240.324(3), Florida Statutes, indicates that the local college board of trustees address within the annual evaluation of presidents the achievement of the performance goals established by the accountability process. Further, Section 240.3355(3), Florida Statutes, dictates that the local college board of trustees annually evaluate the performance of the community college presidents in achieving their annual and long term equity goals and objectives.

The Chancellor of the Division of Community Colleges has reviewed the evaluations submitted by the local boards for the 28 community colleges and certifies that the colleges have reported that they have reviewed the presidents with regard to these mandated areas.

The report is submitted for acceptance by the Florida Board of Education.
