SUBJECT: University of South Florida Campus Master Plan Amendment

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve a proposed amendment to the current USF Adopted Campus Master Plan (CMP).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

USF has submitted a proposed amendment to its 1995 Adopted Campus Master Plan. The proposed amendment consists of changes to the Housing, Recreation, and Open Space Land Use Elements and an updating of all affected plans and maps. Adoption of the proposed changes results in no net decrease in greenway areas on the campus. These changes relocate greenway space to compatible locations and provide for future location of planned facilities.

USF has identified no off-campus impacts to natural resources, public services or other public facilities. The proposed amendment is consistent with the goals, objectives, and policies of the Adopted Master Plan. Land uses remain compatible with the adjacent land uses both on-campus and off-campus. The proposed amendment does not exceed the thresholds established in Subsection 240.155(9), F.S. This meeting of the Florida Board of Education is the only public hearing that is required. The proposed amendment will be sent to the host government for a courtesy review. The Department of Environmental Protection, Office of Environmental Services, acting on behalf of the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund, approved the Amendment January 31, 2002. This amendment is required to be approved so that the university may be approved to sell bonds for the residence life project also included in this agenda.
