BACKGROUND INFORMATION

SB 1162, enacted by the 2001 Florida Legislature, established specific roles for the Florida Board of Education, the Secretary of the Florida Board, the Commissioner of Education and the State Board of Education in the state's K-20 seamless education governance structure. The discussion will review the statutory responsibilities of each entity during the transition to the K-20 structure in 2003, areas of coordination and expectations of tasks to be completed.
