SUBJECT: Board Approval of Plans to Implement Legislation

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

To adopt a plan to implement K-20 Accountability (HB 915).

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Section 1001.02, Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

During the 2003 Regular Session, the Legislature passed House Bill 915. House Bill 915 requires the State Board of Education to adopt guiding principles for establishing state and sector-specific measures and standards.

- The State Board of Education will cooperate with each delivery system to develop proposals for performance-based funding, using performance measures
- The State Board of Education must adopt common definitions, measures, standards, and performance improvement targets by December 1, 2003
- The Department of Education must recommend to the Legislature a formula for performance-based funding that applies accountability standards for the individual components of the public education system at every level, kindergarten through graduate school by December 1, 2004
- The State Board of Education must adopt guidelines required to implement performance-based funding that allows institutions and school districts 1 year to demonstrate achievement of specified performance standards
