PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve Collective Bargaining Agreement Supplement between the Florida Board of Education and the FAMU Graduate Assistants United. through January 7, 2003.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Florida Board of Education and the FAMU Graduate Assistants United (GAU) expires January 7, 2003. The Florida A&M University board of trustees will become the public employer and assume all collective bargaining functions on January 7, 2003, and the FBOE and the FAMU GAU have agreed to implement salary increases pursuant to the provisions of the 2002 General Appropriations Act. The parties also agreed to other minor technical changes.
