SUBJECT: High School Credit Equivalencies for English Dual Enrollment Courses

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Motion to approve the list of recommended high school credit equivalencies for English dual enrollment courses.

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

1003.436. Definition of "credit". The State Board of Education shall determine the number of postsecondary credit hours earned through dual enrollment pursuant to s. 1007.271 that satisfy the requirements of a district's interinstitutional articulation agreement according to s. 1007.235 and that equal one full credit of the equivalent high school course identified pursuant to s. 1007.271(6).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1007.21, Florida Statutes, requires the Commissioner of Education to appoint faculty committees to identify postsecondary courses that meet high school graduation requirements. The attached list represents the work of an English faculty committee, as well as the review and approval of the Articulation Coordinating Committee. Upon approval, the attached list of dual enrollment English courses will receive one full high school English credit beginning with the spring semester of the 2003-2004 school year.
