SUBJECT: Tenure Nominations as a Condition of Employment

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve granting tenure to the nominees listed.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The following nominees from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University have been recommended for tenure as a condition of employment:

Joan R.M. Bullock, Frederick D. Greene, William D. Henslee,
Lundy R. Langston, and Omar Saleem.

Rule 6C-5.940, the SUS rule on Tenure and Permanent Status, and provisions of the collective bargaining agreement with the United Faculty of Florida, require that university decisions on faculty tenure be brought forward to the Board for final approval. These actions were previously brought to the Board of Regents and are brought to the FBOE as a result of the Type II transfer.

Tenure as a condition of employment is awarded to distinguished faculty who have been hired by Florida's universities from other institutions and who have previously earned tenure. Awarding tenure upon hire serves to attract quality faculty to Florida's institutions.

These faculty appointments will be responsible for the initial planning and program development of the law school with teaching responsibilities beginning in the fall semester.
