SUBJECT: Presidential Evaluations

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approval of draft categories of accountability that must be considered in presidential evaluations. Presidential evaluation is a responsibility of boards of trustees. The Florida Board of Education has the duty to provide broad policy guidance to trustees on the areas of presidential responsibility that are grounded in the vision for k-20 governance and the new status of community colleges and universities. If approved, the evaluation areas will be presented to boards of trustees for comment. A final product will be presented at the December 2001 meeting.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Staff reviewed Senate Bill 1162 for language pertaining to the responsibilities of the University Boards of Trustees, university presidents, and related accountability measures. A review of the synthesis of information resulted in a grouping of areas into broad categories of responsibility. The handout provides the recommended categories and, to illustrate the area, summary items of the specific language found in Senate Bill 1162.
