Ms. Albright has also designed funding strategies for 4-year colleges, community and technical colleges, medical, agriculture, and research programs in Louisiana, facilitated the work of the Missouri Higher Education Funding Task Force which developed new funding policies for that state's 2 and 4-year institution and created a new funding incentive system for the University of Maine system. In addition, Ms. Albright facilitated the work of the Illinois Community Colleges' Funding Task Force, designing new budget priorities and changing the funding formula, and prepared a report on the academic, financial and planning activities for the Texas Coordinating Board for Higher Education.
