Sunlink needed for Cooperative Purchasing - look at what neighboring schools have and purchase different titles

Sunlink interlibrary loan use has skyrocketed in our district due to shrinking budgets

Sunlink assists with book challenges

Sunlink assists with Differentiated Accountability & RTI (Response To Intervention)  
Individualized and customized bibliographies can be developed by reading level and interest level for all readers - especially beneficial for struggling readers

Sunlink should expand Data Project - St. Johns has been looking at FCAT Reading data and library circulation since 2002

We have seen an increase in each level...

Elem. 2007 21.5 books per student 2009 40.7 books per student

Middle Sch 2007 10.1 books per student 2009 25.3 books per student

High Sch 2007 2.8 books per student 2009 18.1 books per student
