

A Dozen Questions to Ask Your Child's Language Arts Teacher

- 1. What are the major literacy goals for this grade level?
- 2. What are the language arts standards for this grade level and what do I need to know about them?
- 3. If my child struggles with reading or writing, how will we work together to help my child improve?
- 4. Do you have suggestions for how I can motivate my child to read and write more outside of school hours?
- 5. Can you give me some examples of how you will assess my child's learning in your classroom?
- 6. How will you use my child's test data to increase his/her literacy development?
- 7. Tell me about your expectations for language arts homework.
- 8. What kinds of questions do you suggest I routinely ask my child about your class?
- 9. Can you share some ways parents are involved in education at this school?
- 10. Is there a specific volunteer activity I can do that would be helpful to you?
- 11. What resources do you or this school offer families?
- 12. What am I not asking, but should be?
