She is admired by her colleagues, peers, and students for her dedication to Chinese language instruction. Her experience, education, and accolades are extremely impressive. Ms. Wong has authored or co-authored over six Chinese language instruction publications since 1996. She is a respected teacher, administrator, and community member. Zhen Bang! is designed for the American high school student with a design that is colorful, inviting, and engaging. It is aligned with the National Standards and incorporates 21st Century Skills. Zhen Bang! begins with an overview of Chinese pronunciation, geography, history, and lays a foundation for the study of Chinese characters. It uses standard Mandarin Chinese and simplified characters. Zhen Bang! presents lively dialogues and encourages student to talk about their lives, family, friends, school, home, etc. in paired and group communicative activities. Chinese culture is integrated throughout the text and the audios and videos use native-speaking teens.
