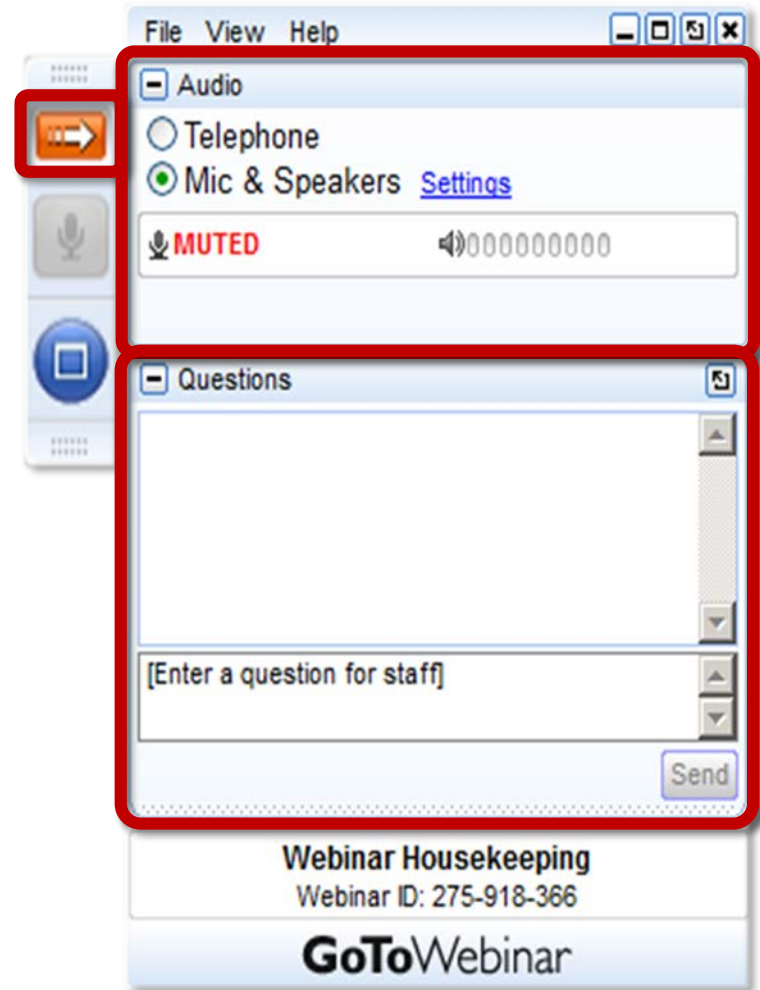

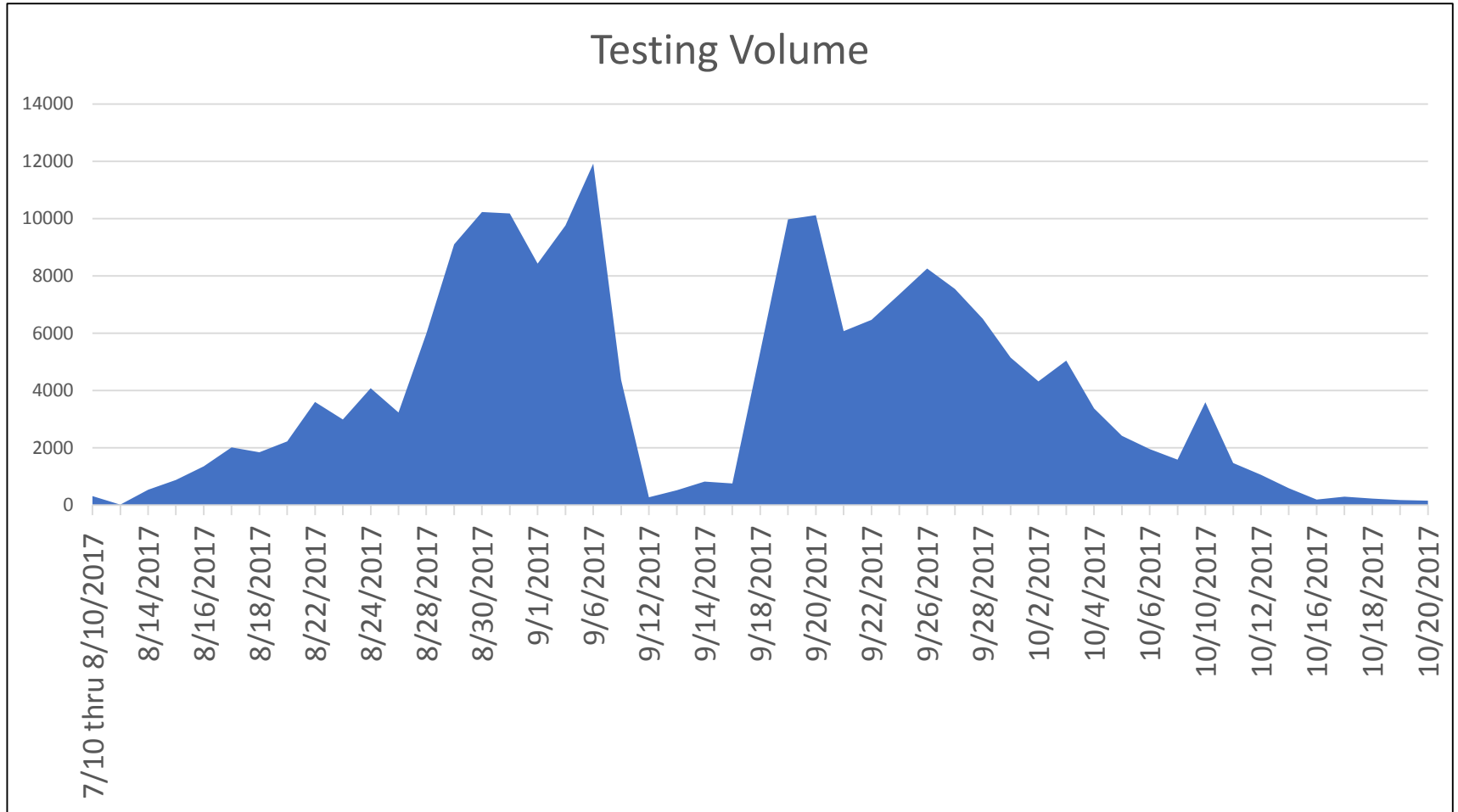

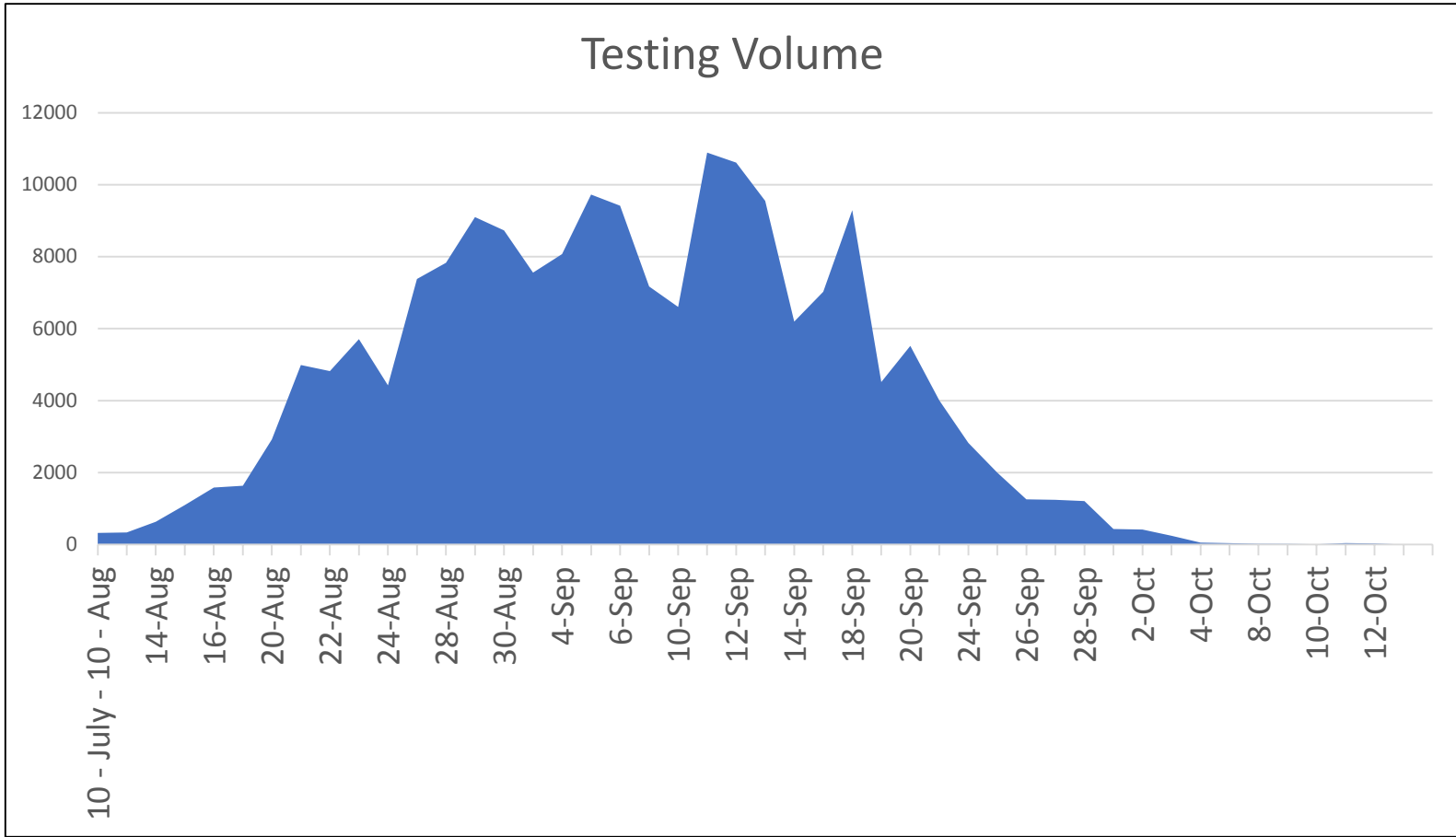

FLKRS Test Activity – 2017



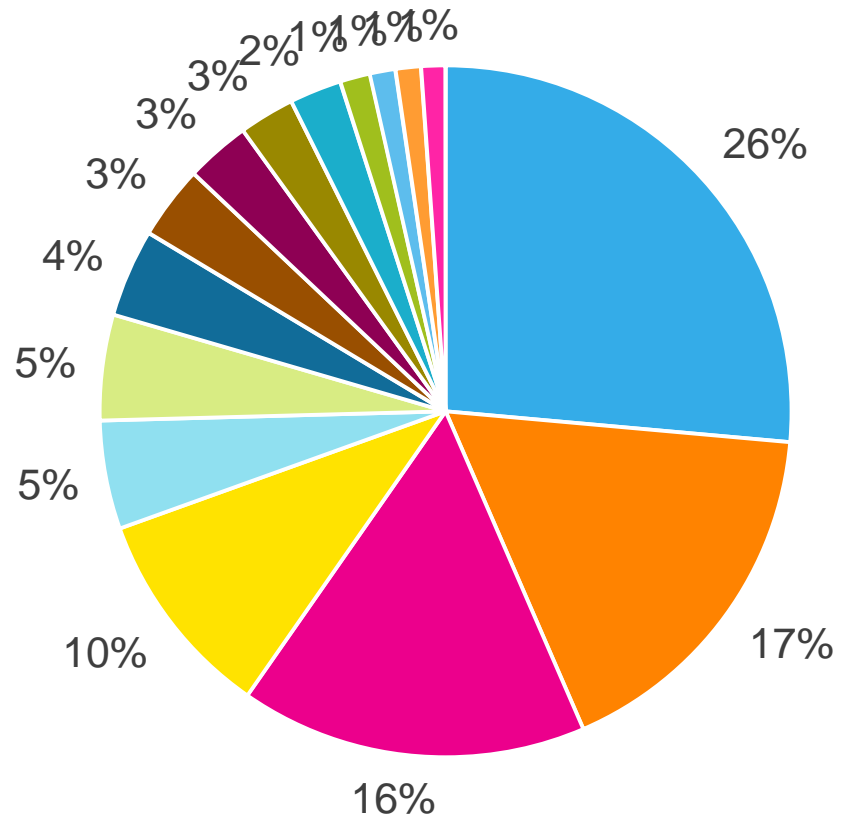
FLKRS Test Activity – 2018

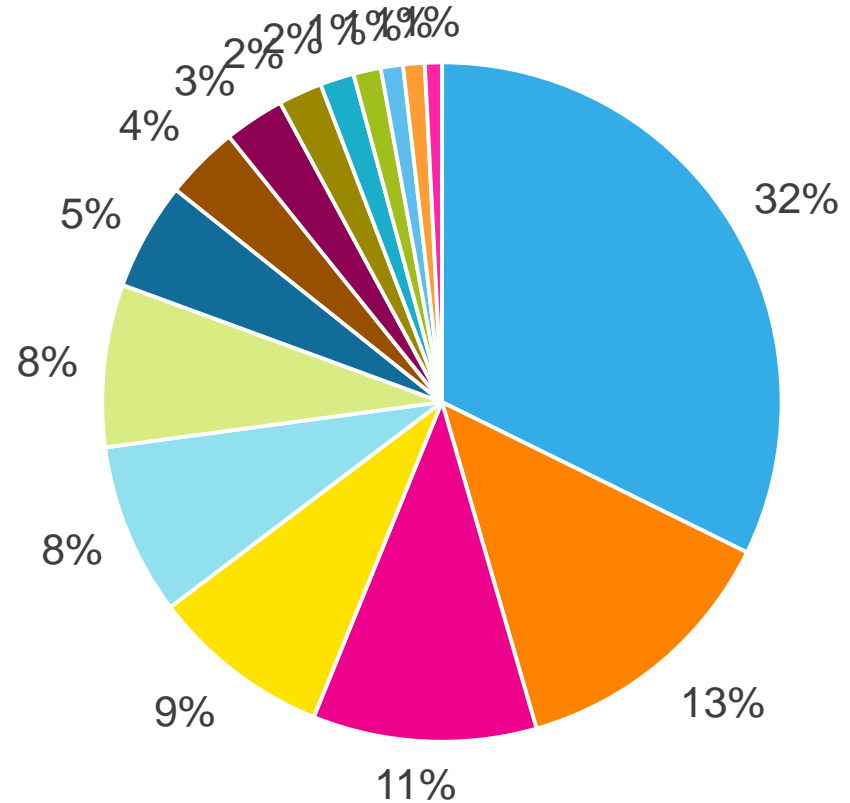

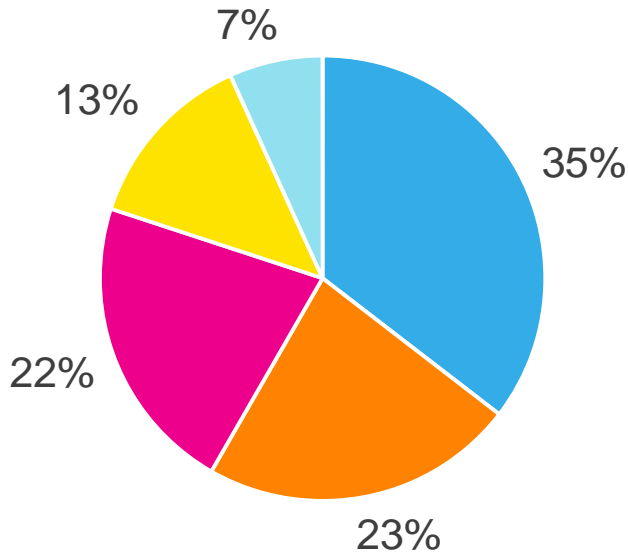

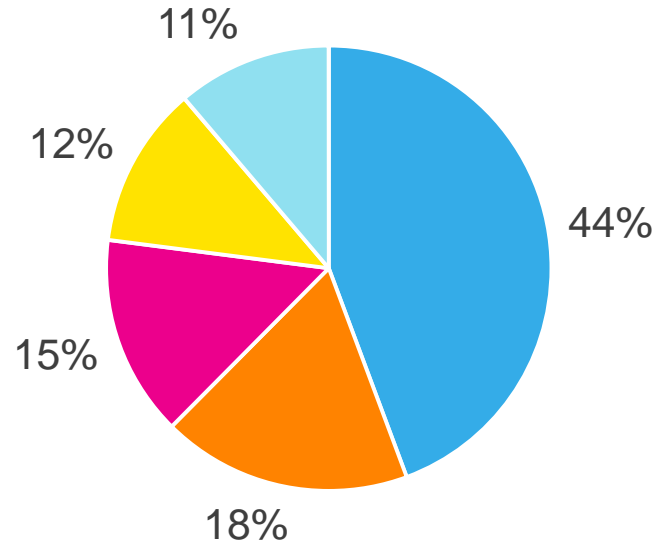

- 44% Username/password
- 18% Student enrollment
- 15% Reports
- 12% Monitor password
- 11% Login URL



Lessons Learned

Student enrollment

- Rostering changes implemented this year made a big difference
- Renaissance increasing their staff reduced private school rostering bottlenecks and overall time to process templates

Username and Passwords

- The username/password format created this year resulted in a lot of calls
 - Renaissance and FDOE will collaborate on possible solutions.

Reports – test activity, test results, generic

- We did better this year on reports.
- We will continue to add report information to future webinars/PD opportunities.
