PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consideration of Cycle 1, Year 1 Turnaround Option Plans for Approval

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Section 1008.33, Florida Statutes

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Florida's school improvement system, also known as Differentiated Accountability (DA), requires schools that earn a D or F grade complete a process for improved student performance. Any school earning a D or F grade immediately enters the DA system and is provided assistance of escalating intensity by the DA staff.

This action item includes the turnaround option plans for 3 schools in 2 districts in their first year of implementation (2018-19). These schools earned at least two consecutive grades of D or a grade F and must immediately implement intervention and support strategies prescribed in s. 1088.33 (3)(c), F.S.

Upon approval, the districts will implement their turnaround option plans (all districts selected district-managed turnaround) for two school years unless the school improves to a C grade or better in 2018-19. At the end of the two-year implementation period, those districts whose schools have not improved to a C grade or better, will present a new turnaround option plan to the state board for consideration.
