## **Notes & Reminders**

- Governor DeSantis issued <u>Executive Order 19-32</u>, "Raising the Bar for Civic Literacy"
  - Commitment to identifying opportunities to equip high school graduates with sufficient knowledge of American civics, particularly the principles reflected in the Unites States Constitution, so Florida graduates are capable of discharging their responsibilities associated with American citizenship.
- The department began soliciting input on the civics instructional materials and test specifications on August 15, 2019, as part of its response to the Executive Order, as well as <u>CS/HB 807</u>.
- Input will be collected through October 15, 2019.

## **Reminder: Civics Review Timeline**

- Review of state-adopted instructional materials open August 15 and are due by October 15.
- Commissioner to give recommendations for improvements by December 31, 2019.
- Review of Civics education standards to begin in 2020, and recommendations due December 31, 2020.
- State Board adoption of potential new standards in early 2021.
- Call for Social Studies instructional materials, including Civics, begins November 2021.
