- An ICP is intended to assist with the continuation of instruction and other related educational services during times of disruption to standard operations.

Project Overview

- \$7,000,000 allocated to support the development of ICPs.
- All LEAs are eligible to apply for this opportunity.
 - Funding is available to public schools, and services are available to non-public schools.
- Application is due in ShareFile by March 12, 2021.
 - DOE 100A, DOE 101S, and narrative form.
- By September 30, 2021, all LEAs must develop and submit an ICP in the format prescribed by the Department.

Allowable Expenses

- Costs to develop the LEA ICP
- Attendance at Florida Department of Education (FDOE) sponsored professional development (PD)
- Reasonable and Necessary
 - Training, development, and communication related to an ICP
- Technology Purchases
 - Up to 15% used on hardware

Charter School and Non-Public School Allocation

- LEAs must provide a minimum of \$3,000 per public charter school.
- LEAs must reserve a proportionate share to provide equitable services to participating non-public schools.
