

<b>Element Name: Student Instructional Hours</b>	
<b>Definition</b>	
Student Instructional Hours is a <b>whole number</b> , expressed in hours, assuming <u>no decimal places</u> and right justified for this course for the term being reported.	
<p><b><u>EXAMPLE:</u></b>                    5    250</p>	
Summary of language in Rule 6A-10.0381 on reporting AGE Instructional hours:	
Instructional contact hours for the classroom instruction are those scheduled classroom hours that occur between the date of enrollment in a class and the withdrawal date or end-of-class date, whichever is sooner. A student may be reported only for the instructional contact hours that are scheduled for attendance.	
Scheduled classroom hours means the time the class is scheduled to meet.	
If a student completes a literacy completion point (LCP) which results in a change in the program or course prior to the scheduled end of the class, report the instructional contact hours to the date the LCP was earned.	
If a student transfers from one class to another course section, separately report the instructional contact hours in the first class from the date of enrollment to the date of transfer and the instructional contact hours in the second class from the date of transfer or date of enrollment in the new section to the final withdrawal date or the end of the class, whichever is sooner.
