On January 21, 2014, the State Board of Education established Achievement Levels for the U.S. History End-of-Course (EOC) Assessment. Winter 2013 U.S. History EOC Assessment scores were reported to students on the new score scale, but at that time, the Achievement Levels had not been established. The Winter 2013 results have been retrofitted to the established Achievement Levels so that stakeholders and the general public are able to see what the results would have been if the Achievement Levels had been approved and implemented at that time.

To provide meaningful results and to protect the privacy of individual students, data are not reported when the total number of students in a group is fewer than 10 or when all the students in a group are in the same category (i.e., all in the same Achievement Level or all in the Percentage Passing).
