

Career and Professional Academy Enrollment and Performance Report, 2010-11

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At a Glance

In 2010-11, the fourth year of implementation of the Florida Career and Professional Education Act, school districts registered 1,298 career and professional academies, representing all 67 of Florida's school districts. This study found the following regarding enrollment patterns and student academic performance:

- The most frequent career cluster represented by academies was Information Technology with 218 registered academies followed by Health Sciences with 180 academies.
- Academy students were most likely to be tenth-graders compared to the non-academy population, which is over-represented by ninth-graders.
- The distribution of students by race and gender among academy students was similar to that of non-academy students.
- Among the 154,327 students enrolled in career and professional academies, 24,910 or 16.1 percent, were reported as having earned one or more approved industry certifications going back to the 2007-08 school year.
- In the 2010-11 school year, 20,644 academy students earned 23,088 certifications with a pass rate of 73.6%.
- Academy students, particularly freshmen, had, on average, higher cumulative grade point averages than non-academy high school students.
- Academy students were less likely to be chronically absent, drop out, or be subjected to disciplinary actions than non-academy students.
- Academy students were more likely to take Advanced Placement or dual enrollment courses than their non-academy counterparts.
- Both academy participation and the earning of industry certifications correlated with higher student performance than among peer high school students.

Introduction

According to section 1003.492(3), Florida Statutes (F.S.), the Florida Department of Education (DOE) shall conduct an annual analysis of student participation and performance in industry certified secondary career and technical programs authorized by the Career and Professional Education Act. Performance indicators for students enrolled in career and professional academies (also referred to as *CAPE academies* or simply *academies* in this report) include, but are not limited to, graduation rates, retention rates, Florida Bright Futures Scholarship awards, additional educational attainment, employment records, earnings, industry certification, and employer satisfaction. The results of this study shall be submitted to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives annually by December 31.

Background

In 2007 the Florida Legislature passed the Career and Professional Education Act. The purpose of the Act was to provide a statewide planning partnership between the business and education

communities in order to attract, expand, and retain targeted, high-value industry and to sustain a strong, knowledge-based economy. The objectives of the Act are as follows:

- To improve middle and high school academic performance by providing rigorous and relevant curriculum opportunities;
- To provide rigorous and relevant career-themed courses that articulate to postsecondary-level coursework and lead to industry certification;
- To support local and regional economic development;
- To respond to Florida's critical workforce needs; and
- To provide state residents with access to high-wage and high-demand careers.

To implement the legislation, the Act created statewide partnerships among the Department of Education, the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), and Workforce Florida, Inc. (WFI). Section 1003.491(2), F.S., requires that each district school board develop a five-year strategic plan to address and meet local and regional workforce demands. This plan must be developed in collaboration with a district's local workforce board and local postsecondary institutions. A required element in this plan was the provision for at least one operational career and professional academy per school district, pursuant to s. 1003.492(2), F.S., by the beginning of the 2008-09 school year.

Career and Professional Academies

A career and professional academy is a research-based program that integrates a rigorous academic curriculum with an industry-specific curriculum aligned directly to priority workforce needs established by regional workforce boards. According to section 1003.493(4), F. S., each career and professional academy must:

- 1) Provide a rigorous standards-based academic curriculum integrated with a career theme;
- 2) Include one or more partnerships with postsecondary institutions, businesses, industry, employers, economic development organizations, or other appropriate partners from the local community;
- 3) Provide shared, maximum use of private sector facilities and personnel;
- 4) Provide personalized student advisement;
- 5) Promote and provide opportunities for students to earn Bright Futures scholarships;
- 6) Provide instruction in high-growth, high-demand, and high-pay careers;
- 7) Deliver instruction relevant to the applicable career, including intensive reading and mathematics intervention;
- 8) Offer applied courses that combine academic content with technical skills;
- 9) Provide instruction resulting in competency, certification, or credentials in workplace skills;
- 10) Provide opportunities for students to obtain the Florida Ready to Work credential;
- 11) Include an evaluation plan;
- 12) Include a plan to sustain career and professional academies; and
- 13) Redirect appropriated career funding to career and professional academies.

Districts are required to annually register with the DOE career and professional academies that meet the requirements of s. 1003.493, F.S., during a reporting window of July 15 to September 15. Superintendents certify that each registered academy meets all of the requirements in statute.¹

Industry Certifications

A key component of this Act is a focus on industry certifications that are critical to Florida's employers. The legislation tasked the DEO with defining "Industry Certification." The Department's definition was the following:

"A voluntary process, through which individuals are assessed by an independent, third-party certifying entity using predetermined standards for knowledge, skills and competencies, resulting in the award of a time-limited credential that is nationally recognized and applicable to an occupation that is included in the workforce system's targeted occupation list or determined to be an occupation that is critical, emerging or addresses a local need."

The Act required that DOE "develop and adopt rules for implementing an industry certification process" as an essential element of implementing the new law. The process described in Rule 6A-6.0573, Florida Administrative Code, has two stages. In the first stage, WFI produces an annually updated list of industry certifications that ensure skill proficiency, address emerging labor market and industry needs, and are based on the highest available national standards. This list is reviewed and approved by the WFI board and must be annually published according to the requirements of s. 1003.492(2), F.S. This list is known as the "Comprehensive Industry Certification List" and is published annually on March 1.

From this comprehensive list, the Department of Education develops the Industry Certification Funding List in the second stage of the process. This list is a subset of items on the Comprehensive Industry Certification List, based on the following criteria:

- 1) The certification must be achievable by students in a secondary-level program;
- 2) The certification must require a minimum of 150 hours of instruction; and
- 3) The certification must have been offered for at least one year in a school district. The Commissioner of Education may waive the one-year requirement when failure to do so would inhibit preparation of students for emerging workforce opportunities.

Funding Incentives

For each student enrolled in a registered career and professional academy who earns a certification on the "Industry Certification Funding List" and graduates with a high school diploma, the district of instruction may earn 0.3 full-time equivalent (FTE) student membership for the following year's funding calculation in the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP).² Certifications earned through dual enrollment are not eligible for additional FTE. The additional FTE may not exceed 0.3 per student (i.e., no repeat allocations for additional certifications).

Data reported for 2009-10 is used for the 2010-11 FEFP calculation. For the 2010-11 FEFP, 3,754 students who graduated in 2009-10 generated 1,126.20 additional FTE in the K-12 funding formula. The estimated value of this FTE in the FEFP calculation is about \$4.1 million.

Accountability

An accountability mechanism included in the Act requires that 50 percent of students enrolled in each career and professional academy course who sat for industry certification exams or attempted college credit either passed a certification exam or earned college credit in the second year the course was offered. In the third year the threshold increases to 66 percent. In the subsequent year, districts may not offer or report industry certifications associated with courses that do not meet the thresholds.

Scope

This analysis addresses the following questions:

- 1) How many career and professional academies are there and where are they located?
- 2) How many students are enrolled in career and professional academies and what are their characteristics?
- 3) How many and what type of industry certifications have career and professional academy students earned?
- 4) How did career and professional academy students perform academically compared to other high school students?
- 5) What were the postsecondary and employment placement outcomes for 2009-10 career and professional academy graduates?

Bright Futures eligibility data for 2010-11 seniors were not available in time for publication of this report. These findings will be published in early 2012 as a supplemental report, and an addendum will be transmitted to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

Method

Data were extracted from the DOE Student Information System for academic year 2010-11 (Survey 5 as of October 20, 2011).³ Data on career and professional academy characteristics are from the DOE academy registration database. Data on schools housing academies was obtained from the Florida School Indicators Report.

Findings

Profile of Career and Professional Academies

In academic year 2010-11, 1,298 career and professional academies registered in Florida, and 1,230 (94.8 percent) of these academies reported student enrollments in 2010-11. All of Florida's 67 school districts registered at least one career and professional academy with DOE. The five districts with the most registered academies were Hillsborough (225 academies), Miami-Dade (163), Broward (124), Palm Beach (88), Orange (51), and Clay (49). Table 1 shows the two-year distribution trend of Florida's registered career and professional academies and enrollment by school district. Two districts with registered academies reported zero students for the 2010-11 academic year: Glades and Madison.⁴ For a map of the geographic distribution of career and professional academy enrollments, see Appendix A.

Characteristics of Schools that House Academies

When compared on other indicators, schools with at least one academy differed somewhat from those with no academies. The average percentage of students who were economically disadvantaged⁶ among high schools with at least one academy was 47.8 percent compared to 58.2 percent among high schools with no academies. The percentage of chronically absent students was higher in academy schools (15.1 percent) than among non-academy public high school (8.4).⁷ The percentage of students who were English language learners among academy schools (5.3 percent) was lower than that of non-academy high schools (9.9 percent).⁸ For a listing of indicators for each school with at least one academy, see Appendix B.

Academy Curriculum

The curricular foci of registered academies fall under specific career clusters. A career cluster is a broad group of related occupations based on commonalities in knowledge and skills required to perform job tasks. The most frequent career cluster represented by academies registered in 2010-11 was Information Technology with 218 academies (see Table 2). The second most frequent cluster represented was Health Sciences with 180 registered academies.

In 2010-11, there were 154,327 students grade 9-12 registered in career and professional academies, representing 18 percent of the entire high school population.⁹ Academy students were most likely to be tenth-graders compared to the general high school population, which has more ninth-graders than any other grade level (see Table 3).

Demographic Profile

Table 4 below shows that the distribution of academy students by race and gender categories was similar to that of non-academy students. Among academy students, slightly more were male (51.5 percent) than female (48.5 percent). Forty-six percent of academy students were White, and the largest minority populations were Hispanics (26.3%) and African-Americans (21.9%). Compared to academy students, a slightly lower percentage of non-academy students were White (45.0 percent), Hispanic (25.9 percent), and Asian (2.4 percent); non-academy students were slightly more likely to be African-American (23.7 percent).

Performance of Career and Professional Academy Students

This section will address the performance of career and professional academy students. The indicators addressed will include the following:

- 1) The number and percentage of academy students obtaining industry certifications;
- 2) Cumulative grade point average of academy and non-academy students;
- 3) Student engagement indicators of academy and non-academy students including chronic absenteeism, disciplinary actions, and dropout rates; and
- 4) Postsecondary readiness as indicated by the percentage of academy and non-academy participation in Advanced Placement and dual enrollment courses.

Performance levels on these indicators are reported at the aggregate state-level, summing up all academy and non-academy students statewide, grades 9-12. Performance levels for each registered academy can be found in Appendix C.

Industry Certification

Among the 154,327 students enrolled in career and professional academies, 24,910 or 16.1 percent were reported as having earned one or more approved industry certifications in their high school careers going back to the 2007-08 school year; 20,644 students earned certifications in

2010-11 alone.¹⁰ A total of 31,389 assessments were attempted by academy students in 2010-11, of which 23,088 were passed, resulting in a pass rate of 73.6 percent. Among the 82 different certifications attempted by academy students in 2010-11, the top three were Adobe Certified Associate (Photoshop), Adobe Certified Associate (Dreamweaver), and Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Bundle (see Table 5).

The higher the grade level of academy students, the greater the number of industry certifications earned. Forty-one percent of industry certifications earned by career and professional academy students were awarded to 12th graders (see Table 6). Among ninth-graders, 2,887 certifications were earned, representing 12.5 percent of total certifications reported. The progression in the number of certifications as grade level increases is expected given the time and training required to earn industry certifications.

Table 7 shows the distribution of earned student certifications by school district. Palm Beach reported the highest number of reported certifications with 3,219, which represented 13.9 percent of all certifications reported in the state for career and professional academy students. Second highest was Broward with 2,576 certifications, or 11.2 percent, followed by Miami-Dade with 2,162, or 9.4 percent.

In addition to the 23,088 industry certifications earned by career and professional academy students, 9,859 industry certifications on the funding list were reported as earned by non-academy high school students in 2010-11 for a total of 32,947 certifications earned.

Grade Point Average

Career and professional academy students in 2010-11 had a slightly higher average cumulative GPA of 2.70 compared to 2.64 among the non-academy high school population. When average GPA is disaggregated by grade level (see Table 8), the difference peaks at 10th grade, then declines through 12th grade, where non-academy students had almost the same average GPA.

Student Engagement

Career and professional academies were conceived as a way to offer a relevant curriculum to students. Student engagement can be measured through rates of absenteeism, disciplinary actions, graduation, and dropping out of school. **Academy students were less likely to be chronically absent than non-academy high school students** (see Table 9).¹¹ Among academy students, 14.5 percent were chronically absent compared to 16.2 percent among non-academy students. Chronic absenteeism was more likely among non-academy students across all four grade levels, but, as was the case with GPA, the difference diminished the higher the grade level. The difference among 12th graders is quite small (0.3 percentage points).

Academy students were less likely to have been reported as having disciplinary action taken against them than non-academy high school students (see Table 10). Among academy students, 18.9 percent had at least one disciplinary action on record compared to 20.5 percent among non-academy students. Examining the data by grade level reveals that 9th – 11th grade academy students had a lower percentage of disciplined students than their non-academy peers, but the balance shifts in 12th grade. Among seniors, a higher percentage of academy students were disciplined than their non-academy peers.

Academy students were less likely to drop out than non-academy students, and academy seniors were more likely to graduate with a standard diploma than non-academy seniors. Among academy 12th graders, 88.6 percent graduated with a standard diploma compared to 74.6 percent among non-academy 12th graders. The one-year dropout rate for academy students grades 9-12 (0.7 percent) was 1.4 percentage points lower than that of non-academy students (see Table 11) and was lower across all grade levels.

Postsecondary Readiness and Employment

An indicator of postsecondary readiness is enrollment in accelerated courses (i.e., Advanced Placement, dual enrollment, International Baccalaureate, and Advanced International Certificate of Education courses). Among academy students 28.0 percent took one or more accelerated courses during the 2010-11 academic year. In comparison, the percentage for non-academy students was 23.2 percent.

Among the 2009-10 academy graduate cohort, 65 percent were found in postsecondary education and 46 percent were found employed in the fall of 2010. Comparison data on non-academy students was not available at the time of publication.

Comparison of Career and Professional Academy Participants to Industry Certification Earners

In Table 12 below, career and professional academy students and their comparison group peers are disaggregated by industry certification attainment to isolate the characteristics of academy students and industry certification earners independently. The table shows that as one moves from left (non-CAPE student without certification) to the rightmost column (CAPE student with certification), the performance indicators improve. Both CAPE participants and non-CAPE students who earn certifications performed at a higher level than their non-certified peers. Likewise, both industry certified and non-certified students who participated in CAPE academies performed at a higher level than their non-academy peers. This means that both industry certifications and CAPE academies attract better students, improve academic performance, or both.

A pattern for placement in postsecondary education and employment is less clear. Students with certifications who were not enrolled in CAPE academies were more likely than academy students to be found in postsecondary education in the fall after graduation. On the other hand, CAPE academy graduates with no industry certification were more likely than graduates with certifications to be found employed. This holds true even when graduates found in postsecondary education are removed from the calculation. Comparison data for students who did not participate in an academy or earn an industry certification were not available at the time this report was published.

Four-Year Trends

The number of registered career and professional academies grew from 246 in 2007-08 to 1,298 in 2010-11 (see Table 13). The percentage of Florida high school students enrolled in career and professional academies grew from 2.2 percent to 18.0 percent. The number of academy students earning industry certifications grew from 803 in 2007-08 to 20,644 in 2010-11. As the program ramped up, the pass rate of academy students taking certification exams dropped considerably from 85.7 percent in 2007-08 to 59.6% in 2009-10, but rose to 73.6% in 2010-11.

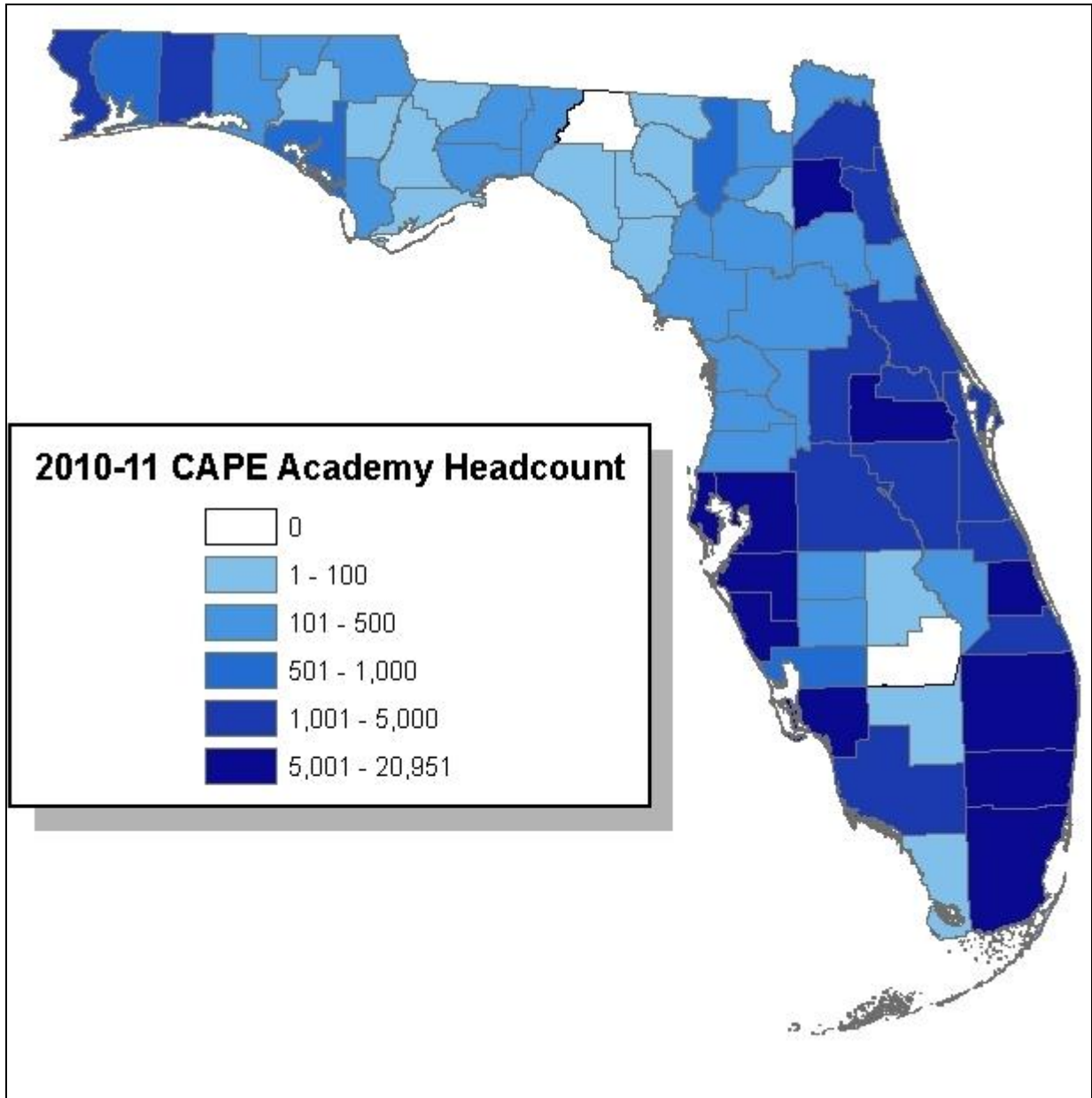

Conclusion

In the fourth year of implementation, the number of career and professional academies and enrolled students continued to grow dramatically across the state. Academy students on average performed better than non-academy students on the following performance indicators: average GPA, chronic absenteeism, dropout rate, and taking accelerated courses. This difference was present even when controlling for industry certification, which, in turn, is characterized by higher student performance even when controlling for academy participation. Both CAPE academy participation and industry certification attainment are associated with higher student performance, but this is not an “apples-to-apples” comparison and cannot be attributed to academy or certification effects.
