If student is enrolled in two or more terms in a reporting period, employment status reported should be for the first term/semester. ▪ Not available should only be reported for terms/semesters that begin prior to agency implementation of the new element. It is expected that by Spring Enrollment, all agencies will have collected employment status for any new or continuing adult education student.
