

In accordance with Florida Statute 1007.27, a home-education student may be considered for admission to St. Petersburg College as a dual enrollment student for any term of the academic year and is exempt from the payment of tuition and registration fees.

The purpose of this program is to provide opportunities for students that will:

1. Increase the depth of their study.
2. Broaden their educational opportunities.
3. Enable them to proceed with their educational goals as rapidly as possible.

A. Program Requirements

1. Students must complete an online St. Petersburg College Application for Admission Form, excluding the application fee.
2. Where applicable, students must demonstrate acceptable test scores for entrance into college-level courses.

3. Students must be enrolled in a secondary curriculum pursuant to F.S. 1002.41 and apply all college credits earned toward completing their home-education program.
4. The CPT/PERT, SAT and ACT test scores are valid for two years.

B. Program Policies

1. Students must maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 in all college-level coursework to remain eligible for the dual enrollment program.
2. Home-education students will have until the conclusion of the term in which the student turns 19 to participate in dual enrollment. Once the student turns 19, the student may not matriculate as a dual enrollment student unless otherwise provided by law.
3. College preparatory (remedial) instruction and physical education courses shall not be included in the dual enrollment program.

C. Procedures for Provision of College Level Instruction

The following documentation is required:

1. Letter certifying the student is eligible and has complied with the requirements as defined in F.S. 1002.41 as a home-education student from the home county school district; renewed annually.
2. College Placement Test scores or other college aptitude exam scores.
