





Accommodations Process





Prior to Assessment

- Use the practice tests
- Teach students how to use features
- Teach students how to use accommodations
- Determine test settings that work best
- Do all of this BEFORE assessment administration



Accommodations Categories

- Flexible Presentation
- Flexible Responding
- Flexible Scheduling
- Flexible Setting
- Assistive Devices and Tools



Flexible Presentation

- Paper-Based Accommodations for CBT
 - Considerations for determining eligibility remain the same
 - Circumstances in which a paper-based accommodation is appropriate:
 - Student cannot access computers
 - Student requires an accommodation that cannot be implemented in a CBT administration
 - Student requires an unavailable CBT form/format
 - Student requires multiple-day testing per session
 - Student is hospitalized/homebound



Flexible Presentation

- Writing Passage Booklets
- Reading Passage Booklets
- Special Documents
 - Large Print
 - Contracted Braille
 - Uncontracted Braille
 - One-Item-Per-Page
 - Used to provide the following accommodations: one test item per page, fewer items per page, increased space between items, true black-and-white print



Flexible Presentation

- Oral Presentation (for all assessments except ELA)
 - Human reader
 - Text-to-speech (CBT form)
- Signed presentation
- Masking (CBT form)



Flexible Responding

- Written, signed, or verbal responses
- Braille responses
- Speech-to-text technology
- Communication devices/computer switches
- Pointing devices
- Special paper
- Blank mathematics grids/guides



Flexible Scheduling

- Brief sessions
- Frequent breaks
- Testing during certain times of day
- Extended time (not unlimited)
 - Student not required to use all of extended time



Flexible Setting

- Individual or small group
- Special lighting
- White noise or approved music
- Special acoustics
- Adaptive or special furniture



Assistive Devices and Tools

- Visual magnification and auditory amplification devices
- Devices that allow access to the computer (may be used with any CBT form)
 - Alternative keyboards
 - Trackballs
 - Joysticks
 - Switch scanning systems
 - Touch screens
 - Mouth sticks
 - Head wands
 - Eye-gaze or head control systems
- Braille manipulatives



Unique Accommodations

- Beginning with Winter 2014, One-Item-Per-Page (PBT and CBT) and Large Print (CBT) are no longer "unique accommodations."
- Student eligibility for ALL paper-based accommodations must be confirmed at the district level and submitted to FDOE.
- We will provide a sample spreadsheet.
- Remember: paper-based accommodations should only be provided for CBT tests if students CANNOT access assessments on the computer.



Exemptions and Waivers

Exemptions from Participation

- Extraordinary Exemption
 - s. 1008.212, F.S.
- Medical Complexity
 - s. 1008.22(9), F.S.

Waiver of Assessment Results

- For the purpose of receiving a course grade or a standard diploma
 - s. 1008.22(3)(c)2 and 3
 - s. 1003.4282(11)(e)



Waiver Decisions

- Students must have a score to waive (which means they must have taken the assessment).
- Assessment waivers should not be predetermined. Students should be encouraged to put forth their best effort on the assessment.
- A waiver should only be awarded if the assessment does not measure the student's progress in achieving the appropriate standards as shown by other evidence.



Waiver Decisions

- A waiver may be awarded after the student has attempted the statewide standardized assessment with all allowable accommodations.
- Teacher evaluations and school grades are still impacted by student scores even if the results have been waived.
- Parents must provide consent for any waivers determined by the IEP team



State Assessment Questions— Who Should You Call?

- 1. Start with your school-based assessment coordinators.
- 2. Talk to your supervisor.
- 3. Work through your district assessment office. (Teachers in small districts should get to know someone in the district assessment office. Make sure district staff know the students with accommodation needs.)
- 4. Call DOE as a last resort!
