SUBJECT: Amended Course Call for 2013-2014 English Language Arts Adoption – ESOL and Electives

The Florida Department of Education has determined it appropriate to postpone the adoption of materials for English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) courses until the 2014-2015 adoption to coincide with the scheduled K-5 ESOL adoption. The English Language Proficiency Standards will be completed and added into all ESOL course descriptions in time for the 2014-2015 instructional materials adoption. Therefore, bids for the ESOL courses listed below will be accepted as part of the 2014-2015 adoption, rather than the current 2013-2014 adoption.

The department has also completed a thorough evaluation of the intents to bid received for the 2013-2014 instructional materials adoption. As a result of the considerable number of intents to bid received, the department will be unable to facilitate a review for non-core, elective English Language Arts courses. Section 1006.28(1) and 1006.40(2), Florida Statutes, require school districts to provide and purchase instructional materials in the core courses of mathematics, language arts, social studies, science, reading, and literature. Elective courses do not fall under this requirement and the department will not have the resources to include them in the 2013-2014 review process based on the expected volume of materials for core courses.
