- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- Must be a high school graduate or have a G.E.D. (Copy to be turned in with application) and have at least one year of algebra;
- Must possess and maintain a valid Florida driver's license (with a good record);
- Must be drug free (Drug test may be required); and
- Must be physically able to perform the work.

All applicants will be considered without regard to race, color, religion, natural origin, age or sex.

Classes will start after Labor Day and be held at Marion Technical College formerly CTAE (Community Technical & Adult Education). Classes are two (2) nights a week from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m.
