## **FFEA Chapter Display Competition**

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Entries will be categorized according to the school level (high school and postsecondary).
- Each chapter may submit only one display.
- Displays are to be created and assembled by student members.

### **GUIDELINES:**

- The display is intended to showcase the chapter and school. Entries should also incorporate the conference theme, "Teach...it's a Choice and an Adventure!"
- Displays must be free standing and mounted on cardboard or foam board.
- Displays must clearly identify the school and/or chapter name.
- Scrapbooks may be included with the chapter display, but are not required.
- All items will be displayed on tabletops provided by the hotel.
- Chapter representatives are encouraged to bring small gifts for distribution to student members from
  other FFEA chapters. Gifts may include, but are not limited to, pens, pencils, stickers, crafts, tokens,
  candy, etc. It is recommended that each chapter bring 450 items in order to ensure that each
  conference participant will receive a gift. (THIS IS OPTIONAL AND WILL NOT EFFECT YOUR SCORE.)
- All chapter displays will need to be removed from the ballroom on Sunday after the closing session.

### **SCORING:**

- The chapter display will be scored using the attached rubric. The points from each category will be totaled in order to determine a winner. The maximum total number of points possible is 100.
- The first, second and third place winners will be announced during the closing session on Sunday.

### **DEADLINE:**

Submit the completed entry form to the FFEA State Coordinator by email (<a href="mailto:edrecruit@fldoe.org">edrecruit@fldoe.org</a>) no later than **Friday**, **November 20**, **2015**.

Chapter display materials must be brought to the conference. Entries should not be delivered to the hotel or the Bureau of Educator Recruitment, Development and Retention prior to the conference.
