Student Essay Competition

ELIGIBILITY:

- Entries will be categorized and judged according to the school level (high school and postsecondary).
- Only one student's essay PER CHAPTER will be considered. Each chapter must select one essay to represent them. If multiple essays are received, they will be disqualified.
- Students entering the essay competition are expected to register for and be present at the conference.
- Students are expected to bring printed copies of their essays with them to the conference. **First place** winners should be prepared to read their essays at the Sunday awards ceremony.

TOPIC:

Teach...it's a Choice and an Adventure!

GUIDELINES:

- Entries must be at least two pages and must not exceed three pages in length.
- Essay must be typed, double spaced, with 1 inch margins using a font no smaller than 12 point.
- Member name, chapter name and grade level must be identified on a cover page attached to the essay.
- If sources are used for the essay, they must be identified on a "Works Cited" page.
- Essay must be on the topic specified above.

SCORING:

- The essay will be scored using the attached rubric. The points from each category will be totaled in order to determine a winner. The maximum total number of points possible is 100.
- The first, second and third place winners will be announced during the closing session on Sunday.
