Individual Employment Plan (IEP)



CURRENT STATUS

- 86 % of IEPs in state are either incomplete or inaccurate
 - Major problems include:
 - Missing or insufficient support, education, or employment goals
 - Employment goals are not 'outcome' goals

Individual Employment Plan



SMART GOALS

- S Specific
- M- Measurable
- A Attainable
- R Reasonable
- T Timely

Individual Employment Plan MOVING FORWARD

- Ensure IEP is an individualized strategic plan
- Ensure each IEP has at least one goal for:
 - -Support (process goal)
 - Education (process goal)
 - Employment (outcome goal tied to O*NET Code)
- Ensure all goals are S.M.A.R.T. goals

Individual Employment Plan



- Develop statewide policy April 1, 2013
- Ensure all new IEPs follow policy Now
- Projects IEP fix plan April 15, 2013
- All IEPs fixed August 15, 2013
