To be eligible for articulation, the student must show evidence of <u>both</u> their FAA Airframe Mechanic and FAA Powerplant Mechanic certifications and they must have been issued within three (3) years prior to their enrollment in the program.			
Rationale/Justification:			
The FAA Airframe Mechanic and FAA Powerplant Mechanic certifications represent industry acknowledgement of technical skill attainment of competencies in the Aviation Maintenance Administration Program.			
Applicability:			
State college administrators statewide were consulted and agreed that the “ FAA Airframe Mechanic and FAA Powerplant Mechanic ” shall articulate <u>twenty four (24)</u> college credit hours to the AAS/AS Degree in Aviation Maintenance Administration . Articulated credit awarded under this agreement may only be applied to the above AAS/AS Degree.
