The Air Conditioning Installation Specialization certification represents industry acknowledgement of technical skill attainment of competencies in the Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, Heating Systems Technology program.			
Applicability:			
State college administrators (statewide) were consulted and agreed that the "Air Conditioning Installation Specialization" shall articulate four (4) college credit hours to the AAS/AS Degree in <u>Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, Heating Systems Technology.</u>			
Articulated credit awarded under this agreement may only be applied to the above AAS/AS Degree and the following College Credit Certificate (CCC) programs: Residential Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, & Heating Systems Assistant (0615050101) and Residential Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, & Heating Systems Technician (0615050102).
