

Postsecondary Preparatory Instructional Placement for 2013 – 2014

The following information is provided to guide instructional placement for students who have not demonstrated college readiness as described under section 1008.30(3), F.S.. The five courses referenced below are academic credit courses, and as such all must satisfy the class size requirements. Given the alignment of course content to the Postsecondary Readiness Competencies, the rigor of the “Success” courses has increased; therefore, these courses may now be awarded academic credit. Important note: Waivers for postsecondary preparatory instruction course(s) enrollment for a student who does not attain a college ready cut score on the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (P.E.R.T) or alternative approved assessments are not available.
