**Jefferson K-12 Somerset Elementary Literacy Plan**  
**Book Study: *The 7 Habits of Happy Kids* by Sean Covey**

<p><b>Monday, January 22</b></p>	<p><b>Habit 3:</b> Put First Things First, The Habit of Integrity and Execution  <b>Objective:</b> Students will learn the importance of prioritizing time management and organization. Students will identify their own big rocks and small rocks.  <b>Activity 1:</b> Watch <u>The Little Red Hen</u>, the students will learn how the little red hen put first things first. The students will learn the importance of putting work before play.</p>
<p><b>Tuesday, January 23</b></p>	<p><b>Read:</b> Pokey and the Spelling Test p. 35-42, in <u>The 7 Habits of Happy Kids Book</u>  <b>Activity 2:</b> Introduce the concept of Big Rocks/Small Rocks (<b>Big Rocks</b> are things that are most important like family, health, church, school, work and <b>Small Rocks</b> are things that are important but not urgent like texting friends, watching TV, spending time on the internet). Students work with a partner to brainstorm Big Rocks and Small Rocks in their life. Students will present their list to the class.</p>
<p><b>Wednesday, January 24</b></p>	<p><b>Activity 3:</b> Watch: <u>Hungry Caterpillar</u>, and talk about how the caterpillar must put first things first to become a beautiful butterfly. Classes will get together with their <b>“Buddy Class”</b> and paint smooth rocks with unique designs. Students will exchange rocks with their Buddy Partner to remind them of the Big Rock Things that are most important in their life.</p>
<p><b>Thursday, January 25</b></p>	<p>Pre-K – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents are invited to read with their child at a <b>“Teddy Bear Tea Party”</b>, held in the Media Center, during the student’s special area time and hot tea and cookies will be served. Students whose parents cannot attend will have their own Teddy Bear Tea Party in their classroom as they read their favorite book to their Teddy Bear, and enjoy cookies.</p>
<p><b>Friday, January 26</b></p>	<p>Guest Readers from the community will be invited to read to each class a pre-ordered book for each grade level.
