Suggested Random Act of Reading: Create a book cover including a selfie depicting the theme *Spreading Literacy, One View at a Time!* On the back cover, you will write a synopsis about yourself as the main character in the book.





Tuesday, January 29th

Suggested Random Act of Reading: Choose a favorite book and select a chapter, section, or scene that "changed your views" as a reader and write a sensory poem about a character or setting from your selection. (The planning sheet for the poem will be provided.)



Wednesday, January 30th

Suggested Random Act of Reading: Choose a favorite book and select a chapter, section, or scene that "changed your views" as a reader and create an illustrated cover for a music CD created for your book.



Thursday, January 31st

Suggested Random Act of Reading: Choose a favorite book and select a chapter, section, or scene that "changed your views" as a reader and draw a cartoon with at least 8 cells which tells the continuation or "the next day" of your book.



Friday, February 1st

Suggested Random Act of Reading: Choose a favorite book and select a chapter, section, or scene that "changed your views" as a reader and create a six word stories. Students have to pack in as much meaning as they possibly can into a story that is only six words long.



Teachers, faculty, and staff will participate in "Favorite Book Selfies", those photos will be featured on the morning show, and media center bulletin board to encourage students to try new books recommended by teachers.

Every day the morning show will feature a student group created song about the importance of reading and literacy in our world. Thank you to Coach Allen's classes!
