### Microsoft Windows 7 Users:



### Microsoft Windows 8.1 Users (IE, Firefox and Chrome):



Flash is built into Chrome 39 and does not require a separate installation. To verify the Chrome Flash version, simply type 'chrome:plugins' in the address bar:


