



# **CORPORATE TAX CREDIT** **Scholarship Program**

## **JUNE REPORT** **2006**

*The Corporate Tax Credit Scholarship Program was established to encourage private, voluntary contributions from corporate donors to non-profit scholarship funding organizations that award scholarships to children from low-income families. A corporation can receive a dollar for dollar tax credit up to 75% of its state income tax liability, and the state may award a maximum of \$88 million in credits each year. This program expands educational opportunities and school choice for children of families that have limited financial resources.*

This report is based on student participation statistics through June of the 2005-2006 school year.





## CTC Student Enrollment by Gender





## CTC Student Enrollment by Grade Level





## CTC Student Racial/Ethnic Enrollment





## CTC Student Enrollment by Scholarship Funding Organization (SFO)


