

Race to the Top Implementation Committee: Teacher Standards Instructional Tool (TSIT)

Purpose and Scope

The purpose of the TSIT committee is to provide input, feedback and recommendations to the state in the development and implementation of the standards instructional tool for teachers. Committee members will be asked to provide guidance and review of the following:

- Job description for instructional technology specialists
- Interview committee for instructional technology specialists
- Identification of a list of prioritized functions to be built into the instructional tool for teachers
- The request for proposals for competitive proposals to build the standards instructional tools for teachers
- The proposals submitted to build the teacher standards instructional tool

The TSIT will begin meeting in Spring 2012 and will continue throughout the Race to the Top grant period. The purpose and scope as described above will progress as the state and participating districts move forward successfully in the development and implementation of the tool.
