STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC – REJECT RULES

17. If Survey Period Code = 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 or 9, then School Number, Zoned School must be filled with zeroes.

→ • If Survey Period Code = 3 and District of Instruction is not 71 and School of Enrollment

○ Is in the range 0001-9899 but not 3518, 7001, 7004, 7006, 7023 and

○ school function setting is not D (DJJ) on MSID and

○ the Charter School Status is Z (not Charter) on MSID and

→ ○ Grade Level code is KG-12 and

○ the Accountability ESE Center is Y or the Primary Service Type is B (Alternative Education) on MSID and

→ ○ Neglected, Delinquent status is not (D) or (N) on MSID

○ then School Number, Zoned School must be an active school for the District Number, Zoned School on the Master School Identification file unless District of Instruction is 68 in which case School Number, Zoned School can also be zeroes.

○ All others, School Number, Zoned School must be zeroes.

(This edit does not apply to Survey Periods 6 and 8.) -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be written to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since the School Number, Zoned School is not zero- filled for survey 2. The fourth record would be rejected since the School Number, Zoned School is not a valid number on the Master School Identification file.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Zoned School and resubmit the records.

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC – STATE VALIDATION

(New Edit for 1314)

➔ **5C.** If Survey Period code is 3 and if Exceptionality, Primary code = M or Exceptionality, Other code = M on the Exceptional Student record, then the School Number, Zoned School must be in the range 0001-9899 but not 3518, 7001, 7004, 7006, 7023. The match between the Student Demographic Information record and the Exceptional Student record should be based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code and Fiscal Year. **(This edit does not apply to Survey Periods 6 and 8) –state validation-**

EXAMPLE

The first and second Student Demographic records listed below would cause a message to be generated because the values for School Number, Zoned School are not valid for Exceptional Student records where Exceptionality, Primary code = M or the Exceptionality, Other code = M.
