STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

➔ 5V. If Survey Period is 2, 3 or 4 and if English Language Learners: Instructional Model is S or C, then Course Number must be a Mathematics, Science, Social Studies or Computer Education course in Appendix DD.

➔ If Survey Period is 1 and if English Language Learners: Instructional Model is S or C, then Course Number must be a Mathematics, Science, Social Studies or Computer Education course in the current or prior year in Appendix DD.

-record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since Course Number 100010 is not a Science, Social Studies, or Computer Literacy course in Appendix DD.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct either the English Language Learners: Instructional Model code or the Course Number and resubmit the record.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

➔ **5W. If Survey Period is 2, 3 or 4 and if English Language Learners: Instructional Model is E or I, then Course Number must be a Language Arts Course Number in Appendix DD.**

➔ **If Survey Period is 1 and if English Language Learners: Instructional Model is E or I, then Course Number must be a Language Arts Course Number in the current or prior year in Appendix DD. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since Course Number 1204000 is not a Language Arts course in Appendix DD.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct either the English Language Learners: Instructional Model code or the Course Number and resubmit the record.

TEACHER COURSE - REJECT RULES

➔ 13. For all numeric courses in Survey Periods 2, 3 and 4, if the Course Number does not meet the description in Appendix R then Highly Qualified Teacher Status code must be Z.

➔ For all numeric courses in Survey Period 1, if the Course Number does not meet the description in the current year or prior year in Appendix R then Highly Qualified Teacher Status code must be Z.

-record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Highly Qualified Teacher Status code is Z and Course Number is included in those requiring a code other than Z.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Highly Qualified Teacher Status code or the Course Number and resubmit the record.

TEACHER COURSE - REJECT RULES

➔ 30. For all numeric courses in Survey Periods 2, 3 and 4, if the Course Number meets the description in Appendix R then Highly Qualified Teacher Status code cannot be Z.

➔ For all numeric courses in Survey Period 1 if the Course Number meets the description in the current year or prior year in Appendix R then Highly Qualified Teacher Status code cannot be Z. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Highly Qualified Teacher Status code is Z and the Course Number is one that meets the description in Appendix R.
