STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

32. If Course Number is not 1200310, 1200320, 1200380, 1209810, 1200390, 2000310, 2000320, 2000322, 2000430, 2000800, 2000850, 2002440, 2002450, 2000340, 1206310, 1206320, 1206810 or 1209820 then Course Assessment Status must be Z. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Course Assessment Status code is not correct for the Course Number reported.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Course Assessment Status code or the Course Number and resubmit the record.

STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - STATE VALIDATION RULES

→ 51. If Course Assessment Status is A, then Credit Earned, Course must be 050 or 100 on this record or on a matching Student Course Transcript Information record. The match is based on Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; School Year – Record Submission and Course Number, which must be one of the following:

- For EOC Algebra 1 courses = 1200310, 1200320, 1200380, 1209810 or 1200390.
- For EOC Biology 1 courses = 2000310, 2000320, 2000322, 2000430, 2000800, 2000850, 2002440, 2002450 or 2000340.
- For EOC Geometry courses = 1206310, 1206320, 1206810 or 1209820.

– state validation-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would not cause an error message to be generated. The third record would cause an error message to be generated because the Credit Earned, Course is 000 and there is no matching record with Credit Earned, Course of 050 or 100.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must either correct the record by changing the Course Assessment Status code or the Credit Earned, Course or the district must submit a matching record with Credit Earned, Course of 050 or 100.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – EXCEPTION REPORT

(New Edit for 1213)



46. If the Online Course Exempt code is D, then there must be a matching Exceptional Student record (based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; and Year) with at least one Exceptionality, Primary or Exceptionality, Other code that is not L. –state validation-

EXAMPLE

The first Student End of Year Status record listed below which is marked with an asterisk would cause a message to be generated because the matching Exceptional Student record has only L and Z codes in Exceptionality, Primary and Exceptionality, Other. The second Student End of Year Status record would pass this edit. The third Student End of Year Status record would cause a message to be generated because a matching Exceptional Student record does not exist.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES

(New Edit for 1213)

➔ 2Q. If the Online Course Exempt code is T then Grade Level must be 12.
-record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Online Course Exempt code is T and the Grade Level is not 12.

**** = Valid fiscal year for data submission.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district should correct the Online Course Exempt code or the Grade Level and resubmit the record.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES

(New Edit for 1213)

→ 2R. Online Course Exempt must be D, T or Z. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second and third records listed below would be rejected. The second record would be rejected because the Online Course Exempt code is an invalid code. The third record would be rejected because the Online Course Exempt field is blank.

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Online Course Exempt codes and resubmit the records.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES

(New Edit for 1213)

- 2S. If FTE Earned: Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates is greater than zero, then Diploma Type must be W06, WFT or WFW. –record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would pass this edit. The second and third records would be rejected because the FTE Earned: Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates is greater than zero and the Diploma Type codes are not W06, WFT or WFW.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must review the Diploma Type codes and the FTE Earned: Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates amounts and correct the items that are in error. The district must then resubmit the records.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES

(New Edit for 1213)

➔ **2T. FTE Earned, Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates must be numeric and must be less than or equal to 1.0000. -record rejected-**

NOTE: Four decimal places assumed.

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second and third records listed below would be rejected. The second record would be rejected because FTE Earned, Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates is not numeric. The third record would be rejected because FTE Earned, Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates is greater than 1.0000.

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the FTE Earned, Unpaid Credits for Early Graduates and resubmit the records.
