STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES



23. If Differentiated Diploma is 1, Diploma Type must be W06, W6A, W6B, W10, WFW, WFT, WFA, WFB, WGD, WGA, W43, W45, or W52. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Differentiated Diploma type is not valid for the Diploma Type reported.

Student Number Identifier, Florida	Diploma Type	Differentiated Diploma
301234567X	W06	1
301234568X	W6A	2
*301234569X	W07	2

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Differentiated Diploma code or the Diploma Type code so that the proper relationship exists and resubmit the record.

STUDENT END OF YEAR STATUS – REJECT RULES

24. Differentiated Diploma must be 1 or Z. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Differentiated Diploma code is an invalid code.

District Number, Current Enrollment	Student Number Identifier, Florida	Differentiated Diploma
30	301234567X	2
* 30	301234568X	4

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Differentiated Diploma code and resubmit the record.
