STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC – STATE VALIDATION

56. If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5 and if the English Language Learners, PK-12 code is LF and if School Number, Current Enrollment is not 3518 and if there is a matching Student Course Schedule or Student End of Year Status record and if District Number, Current Enrollment is equal to District Number, Current Instruction/Service then one of the following must be true for the English Language Learners Information record:

- English Language Learners: Reclassification Exit Date is all zeros and the English Language Learners: Exit Date is within two years of survey date or
- English Language Learners: Reclassification Exit Date is greater than zero and is within two years of survey date.

Use the Survey Period 3 survey date for Survey Period 5 editing.

The match between the Student Demographic record and the English Language Learners record should be based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; and Fiscal Year. If no matching English Language Learners Information record is found, then do not generate an error message. (This edit does not apply to Survey Periods 6 and 8.)

The match between the Student Demographic Information record and the Student Course Schedule record should be based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; and Fiscal Year.

The match between the Student Demographic Information and the Student End of Year Status record should be made based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Student Number, Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; and Year/School Year.

EXAMPLE

An error message would be generated for the Student Demographic Information record marked with an asterisk below. This is because the English Language Learners: Exit Date on the matching English Language Learners Student Information record is more than two years from the survey date for a student with an English Language Learners, PK-12 code of LF.

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC – REJECT RULES

3. If Survey Period Code is 1-4 or 9, School Number, Current Enrollment must be numeric in the range 0001 to 9899, excluding 9001 or it must be 9997, N998 or N999. If Survey Period Code is 5, School Number, Current Enrollment must be numeric in the range 0001 to 9899, excluding 9001 or it must be 9995, 9997, N998 or N999. If Survey Period Code is 6, 7 or 8, School Number Current Enrollment must be numeric in the range 0001 to 9899, excluding 3518 and 9001. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the School Number, Current Enrollment is not in the appropriate numerical range. The fourth record would be rejected because the School Number, Current Enrollment is not numeric, N998 or N999.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Current Enrollment and resubmit the records.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE - REJECT RULES

46. If Survey Period Code is 1, 2 or 3, the first two digits of Period Number must be 00-80 while the last two digits must be 00-80, or 88 and be greater than or equal to the first two digits. If Survey Period Code is 4, the first two digits of Period Number must be 00-80 or 98 and the last two two digits must be 00-80 or 88 and be greater than or equal to the first two digits. -record rejected-

Note: For more information on Period number refer to the DOE Information Data Base Requirements: Volume I -- Automated Student Information System manual.

EXAMPLE

The first three Student Course records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule caused their rejection. The fourth record would be rejected because the Period Number has an ending period with a value less than the beginning period. The last record would be rejected because the last two digits of Period Number are not in the acceptable range.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Period Number and resubmit the records.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE – VALIDATION/NULL EDIT RULES

62. If Survey Period Code is 1, 2 or 3 then

- a student's total FTE Earned, Course during any one survey for a District Number, Current Instruction/Service may not exceed 0.5000,
 - excluding FTE Earned, Course for those courses with the Year-Round/Extended School Year FTE Indicator set to "A" or "B" and
 - ○ excluding FTE Earned, Course for course records where District Number, Current Instruction equals 71 and School Number Current Instruction equals 0500, 0600 or 0700.

If Survey Period Code is 4 and no Student Course Schedule record for the Student Number Identifier, Florida has

- a School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 7001, 7006, 7004, 7023 or
- a School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0300 or 0400 with a District Number, Current Instruction/Service of 71, or
- A School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0500 with a District Number, Current Instruction/Service of 71 and a Grade Level of 04 or 05,
- A School Number, Current Instruction/Service that has a School Function Setting of V on the Master School Identification file and a Charter School Status not equal to Z on the Master School Identification file ,

Then the student's total FTE Earned, Course for the District Number, Current Instruction/Service may not exceed 0.5000 excluding FTE Earned, Course for those courses with the Year-Round/Extended School Year FTE Indicator set to "A" or "B" and excluding FTE Earned, Course for courses with a Period Number of 9800.

→ Matches between student course records should be done using the following fields: Fiscal Year; Survey Period Code; District Number, Current Instruction/Service and Student Number Identifier, Florida.

-state validation/NULL-

→ **FTE Earned, Course set to NULL after the close of the State Records Processing Cycle**

Note: FTE Earned is attributed to the school of instruction unless the school of instruction is a college, university or non-public school in which case the FTE Earned is attributed to the school of enrollment.

EXAMPLE

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE – VALIDATION/NULL EDIT RULES

66. If Period Number is not 9800 and

→ If School Number, Current Instruction/Service is not a private school number on a record with Survey Period Code = 2 or 3,

Then each Student Course record must have a matching Teacher Course record based on the key fields of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/ Service; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number; and Term. -state validation/NULL-

****FTE Earned, Course set to NULL following the close of the State Records Processing Cycle****

EXAMPLE

The first and second Student Course records listed below would pass this edit. The third Student Course Schedule would be flagged in error because of the failure to have a matching Teacher Course Schedule based on the keys of District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Survey Period Code; Fiscal Year; Course Number; Section Number; Period Number; and Term.

STUDENT COURSE SCHEDULE – VALIDATION/NULL EDIT RULES

77. If Survey Period Code is 4 and the School Number, Current Enrollment on this and all of the matching* Student Course Schedule records in Survey 4 are not Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) schools and the student has one or more Student Course Schedule records with

- a School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 7001, 7006, 7004 or 7023, or
- District Number, Current Instruction/Service of 71 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0300 or 0400, or
- District Number, Current Instruction/Service of 71 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0500 and Grade Level of 04 or 05, or
- • District Number, Current Enrollment of 71 and District Number Current Instruction of 71 and School Number , Current Enrollment of 0300 or 0400 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0500, 0600 or 0700, or
- • A School Number, Current Instruction/Service that has a School Function Setting equal to V and Charter School Status not equal to Z on the Master School Identification file, or
- • A Period Number of 9800,

then a student's total FTE Earned, Course for the District Number, Current Instruction/Service for all Survey Period Code 4 records with

- School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 7001, 7006, 7004 or 7023, or
- District Number, Current Instruction/Service of 71 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0300 or 0400, or
- District Number, Current Instruction/Service of 71 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0500 and Grade Level of 04 or 05, or
- • District Number, Current Enrollment of 71 and District Number Current Instruction of 71 and School Number , Current Enrollment of 0300 or 0400 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service of 0500, 0600 or 0700, or
- • A School Number, Current Instruction/Service that has a School Function Setting equal to V and Charter School Status not equal to Z on the Master School Identification file,
- • A Period Number of 9800,

and all Survey Period Code 2 and 3 records (excluding courses in Survey Period Codes 2 and 3 with the Year-Round/Extended School Year FTE Indicator set to "A" or "B") may not exceed 1.0000. DJJ schools are those with a School Function/Setting code of D on the Master School Identification file. -state validation/NULL-
