15. If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5, English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (First) code must be A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, L, R or Z. If Survey Period Code is 7, English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (First) code must be Z. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be added to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (First) code is not valid.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY
