## STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

- ➔ **22. If Course Assessment Status is not A, E or F; then Credit Attempted, Course must be greater than or equal to Credit Earned, Course. -record rejected-**

**NOTE: Two decimal places assumed.**

### EXAMPLE

In the examples below, the second and third records would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause the records to be rejected. The first record would be rejected because the Credit Attempted, Course is less than the Credit Earned, Course.

Course Number	Credit Attempted, Course	Credit Earned, Course
* 1005300	050	100
0900310	050	050
0400330	100	050

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Credit Attempted, Course or the Credit Earned, Course and resubmit the record.

## STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

### ➔ 31. Course Assessment Status must be A-F or Z. -record rejected-

#### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because Course Assessment Status is not a valid code.

District Number, Current Instruction/ Service	Student Number Identifier, Florida	Course Number	Course Assessment Status
02	123456789X	1200310	A
* 02	123456791X	1200300	M

#### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Course Assessment Status code and resubmit the record.

## STUDENT COURSE TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION - EXCEPTION REPORT

86. If Course Grade does not equal F, I, NG, W, or WF and if Course Flag is not N or X and if Course, State Subject Area Requirements is not NC and if Course Assessment Status is not B, C or E; then Credit Earned, Course must be 050 or 100. -exception report-

### EXAMPLE

The second, third and fourth records listed below would pass this edit. The first record would cause an error message to be generated because the student is reported as Course Grade B, but does not have a Credit Earned, Course of 050 or 100.

* ****	1001350	10	B	000

\*\*\*\* = Valid fiscal year for data submission.

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district should review the Course Grade and the Credit Earned, Course information and correct the record if it is in error.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS INFORMATION - REJECT RULES

64. If Survey Period Code is 2 or 3, English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) code must be B, C, D, E, F, G, or Z. If Survey Period Code is 5, English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) code must be B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J or Z. If Survey Period Code is 7, English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) code must be Z. -record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be added to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) code is not valid.

Student Number Identifier, Florida	ELL: Basis of Exit (Second)
123456789X	E
* 223456789X	Q

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the English Language Learners: Basis of Exit (Second) and resubmit the record.

## EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT - REJECT RULES

-  10. Exceptionality, Primary must be C, F-M, O-P, S-W, or Z. -record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second and third records would be rejected because the Exceptionality, Primary code is invalid.

District Number, Current Enrollment	Student Number Identifier, Florida	Exceptionality, Primary
57	571234567X	C
* 57	571234568X	D
* 57	571234569X	Y

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Exceptionality, Primary code and resubmit the records.

## EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT - REJECT RULES

- ➔ 16. If Exceptionality, Primary is not Z; then Exceptionality, Other codes may not include the Exceptionality, Primary code. -record rejected-

### EXAMPLE


The first and third records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Exceptionality, Other codes includes the Exceptionality, Primary code.

District Number, Current Enrollment	Student Number Identifier, Florida	Exceptionality, Primary	Exceptionality, Other
57	571234567X	W	ZZZZZZZZZ
* 57	571234568X	C	FCKZZZZZZ
57	571234569X	Z	ZZZZZZZZZ

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must determine which exceptionality code is in error, correct the record, then resubmit it.

## EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT - STATE VALIDATION/NULL EDIT RULES

 **2J. If Exceptionality, Primary is Z and Survey Period is 5, then Exceptional Student Placement Status must be R, E, I or N. –record rejected-**

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because Exceptionality, Primary is Z but the Exceptional Student Placement Status is not R, E, I, or N.

District Number, Current Enrollment	Student Number Identifier, Florida	Survey Period Code	Exceptional Student Placement Status	Exceptionality, Primary
21	621234567X	5	I	Z
* 21	621234568X	5	P	Z

### RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Exceptionality, Primary or the Exceptional Student Placement Status and resubmit the record.
