17. If Test Score (Entry Assessment - Growth Scale Value Reading) is 0000 then Test Date (Entry Assessment - Reading) must be 00000000. Also, if Test Score is greater than zero then Test Date must not be zeroes. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because there is a Test Date with no Test Score.

Student Number Identifier, Florida	Test Date	Test Score

*223456789X	01222005	0000

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Test Date or Test Score and resubmit the record.
